## The BEACHCup CHAMPIONSHIP:

## OVERVIEW

The BEACHCup is a six-month long points competition culminating with the BEACHCup Playoffs in June. Players vie to become the BEACHCup Champion, which distinguishes the one player who not only performs well during the BEACHCup Regular Season, but also excels through the pressure of the BEACHCup Playoffs.

There is no entry fee for the BEACHCup and this championship will run in conjunction with Saturday Competitions.

## BEACHCUP REGULAR SEASON

The 2024 BEACHCup Regular Season features 24 BEACHCup events beginning with the January Monthly Medal and running through the Saturday Competition on June $15^{\text {th }}$. Members earn BEACHCup points based on their finish in each Saturday competition, with an emphasis placed on wins and high finishes.

## BEACHCup Points Distribution

Monthly Medal events award 600 BEACHCup points to first place.
Non-Monthly Medal Stroke events award 550 BEACHCup points for first place.
Stableford Events award 500 points for first place
BEACHCup Points are awarded by finish position as defined in the point distribution tables. Limited field events during the BEACHCup competition will not redistribute the points for places that do not play.

## Ties

Event winner will be determined by countback system. From $2^{\text {nd }}$ place on, points will be distributed to those in tying positions using the below method. That is, the total points for each tying position will be averaged and that average will be distributed to each player in the tying position.

## BEACHCup PLAYOFFS

At the conclusion of the Regular Season (following the Saturday Competition on June 15), the top 60 players in the BEACHCup standings will be eligible to play in the BEACHCup Playoffs, a series of three events on June $22^{\text {nd }}, 29^{\text {th }}$ and July $6^{\text {th }}$. Points earned during the BEACHCup Regular Season carry over to the first two Playoff event. Players will compete in the BEACHCup Playoffs to be crowned the inaugural BEACHCup Champion!

The BEACHCup Playoffs feature a progressive cut, with fields of 60 for the June $22^{\text {nd }}$ Competition, 40 for Juen $29^{\text {th }}$ and 30 for the 2024 BEACHCup Championship on July $6^{\text {th }}$ where the BEACHCup Champion will be determined. In the event an eligible player is unable or chooses not to play, the field will be shortened, and no alternates will be added.

The first two Playoffs events award 2,000 points to the winner (quadruple points of Regular Season events), while the Playoffs Finale, the BEACHCup Championship, features a stroked-based system as below:

## BEACHCup Championship and Starting Strokes

At the BEACHCup Championship, the player with the lowest stroke total over the 18 holes when combined with his BEACHCup Starting Strokes will be crowned the BEACHCup Champion and be credited with a victory at the BEACHCup Championship.

The BEACHCup points leader after the second Playoff event will begin the TOUR Championship at 10under par. The No. 2 player will start at 8 -under. The No. 3 player starts at 7 -under; the No. 4 player starts at 6-under; the No. 5 player starts at 5-under. Players 6-10 start at 4-under; players 11-15 start at 3 -under; players 16-20 start at 2-under; players 21-25 start at 1-under; and players 26-30 start at even par.

In the event there are tied players at any position going into the TOUR Championship, tied players will be awarded the same number of Starting Strokes for round one. For example, if two players are tied for second position, both players would start at 8 under and the No. 4 player would start at 6 under.

BEACHCup winner may be determined by sudden death playoff if two or more players finish on the same score (taking into account their starting strokes)

## Other Notes

There will a Nett and a Gross* division as part of the BEACHCup. In the Gross division wheStableford events the maximum score for a hole is equal to a nett double bogey*. Players who are on a plus handicap must hole out on the holes that they receive a stroke and mark on scorecard otherwise they will be awarded a double bogey.
*The Gross division is not a true gross event however for the purposes of including stableford rounds in the BEACHCup the above measures need to be included
